There are many people you are likely to be in communication with after a fire. Here are some of the key players you can expect to contact:



A person who represents the insurance company to evaluate the loss. This could be a staff adjuster employed by the company or an independent adjuster under contract with your insurance company.



A person who **protects damaged property from further harm** by
boarding up broken windows, tarping
over a roof, pumping out water etc.



A person who represents the insurance company to sell and service policies. "Captive" agents sell for one specific company, and "independent" agents sell for several different companies.

A sworn law enforcement officer specially trained to identify and collect evidence relating to fires.



A person who **investigates the cause** and origin of fire.



Companies that salvage and clean electronic equipment damaged by smoke and/or root.
